Based on an idea by Dr. [Robert Gallo](#) and [Boif Nath](#) 1973 ([Audio Discussion](#): Gallo, Stolman, Hunt and Others - chd "Interesting Audio Files" Audio No. 2) the first Wilsede Meeting "Modern Trends in Human Leukemia" took place in Dr Toepfer welcomed the scientists from Europe and the United States, and personally led them to Wilsede through heather around Undeloh.

The Wilsede Meetings "Modern Trends in Human Leukemia" are now for 35 years an internationally known and highly regarded scientific discussion forum for qualified scientists.

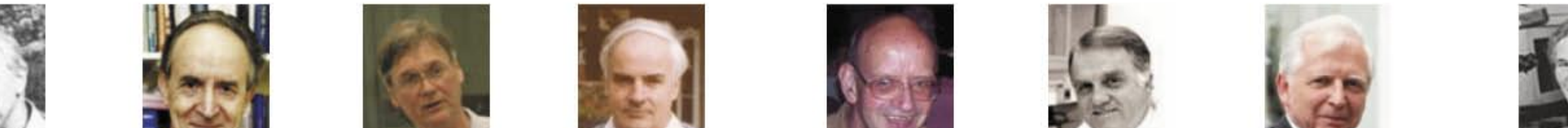
Future Plans
